■ **The continuation of the revolutionary movement, the reaction of the Islamic regime**

With the support of the representatives of the parliaments of the European countries and the representatives of the European Parliament in accepting the political sponsorship of those arrested and at the risk of execution, there are glimmers of hope to stop the executions, especially with a 4-week halt.

January 7 - The execution of two other young men, Mohammad Mehdi Karmi and Seyyed Mohammad Hosseini, showed the enmity and revenge of the Islamic regime against the citizens. Although both of these prisoners had the political sponsorship of the representatives of the European parliaments, but the Islamic Republic ignored their support and executed their death sentences.

While the emphasis in popular gatherings in Iran and abroad was to demand to stop executions and the

with Iran and do not violate the human rights of their citizens like Iran. That is the why they should be asked to stop

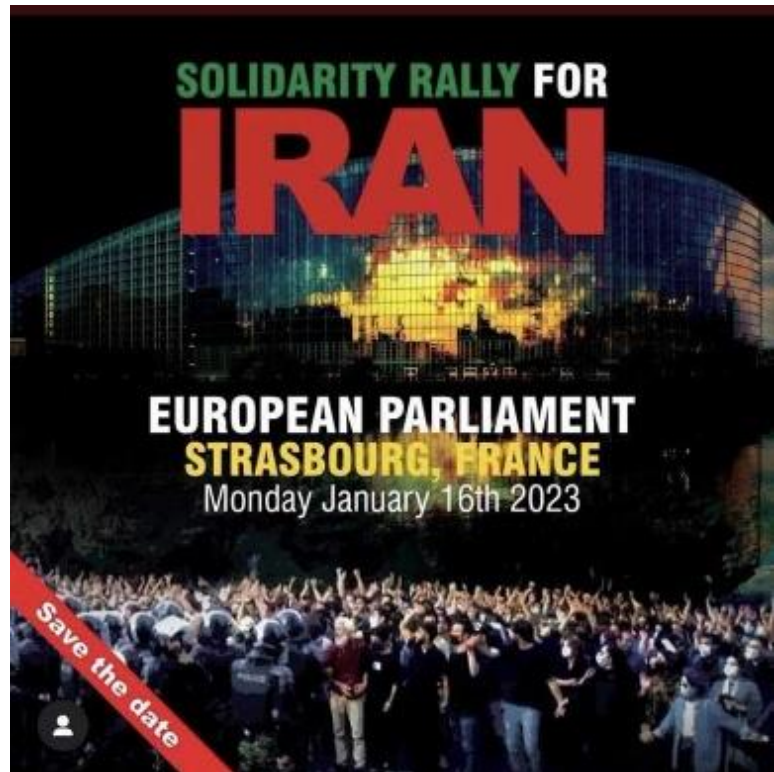
