**Word of the Month** An 'understanding' between Iran and the US?

Last month's rapprochement between the Islamic Republic and Saudi Arabia was rightly understood as a major power re-alignment within the Middle East. Subsequent developments have shed further light on the context of their agreement and, indeed, its unspecified dimensions. Their rapprochement appears to be part of a wider arrangement between Iran and the USA. It is suggested that the latter two countries have agreed to a sort of unwritten 'understanding'.

The development of Iran's nuclear abilities is such that the JCPOA has lost its utility and applicability. Moreover, any formal agreement with Iran would have to pass formal approval of both the US and Iranian legislatures, while an 'understanding' can circumvent this process. This 'understanding' will be 'less for less' but it can have utility and applicability.

The unlocking of some of the Islamic Republic's frozen funds (in South Korea and Iraq) is a part of this 'understanding'. The tightening of the noose around the Mujahidin organization (the Iranian opposition group which was on the US terrorist list for a while) is likely to be another part of this unwritten agreement. If so, this agreement encompasses additional European countries, including Albania, France, etc. We will know more in the coming months.

#### Hostage - Taking Policy

In the last days of May, Asadollah Asadi. the terrorist diplomat of the Republic Islamic was released in exchange for the release of Olivier Vandecastel, a Belgian aid worker imprisoned in Iran. This exchange is the first tangible example of the recent changes in the West's attitude towards the Islamic Republic. "The West" has now put aside its cautious approach in relations with the Islamic Republic, which it had practiced since September of last year, due to the "Women, Life, Freedom" movement.

It is not the first time that the European governments release the organizers of terror and murderers of the Islamic Republic in Europe for the release of the hostages taken bv Iranian regime. The murderers of Shapour Bakhtiar in France and Sadeah Sharafkandi in Berlin have also been released with this type of policy. The same type of measures allows the regime to arrest and imprison citizens of other countries and dualnational Iranians under the title of spies without *fear of the consequences of* taking hostages. This happens, in order to go to the negotiation table with a reliable case at the expense of hostages.



The Left Pary of Iran condemns the release of Asadullah Asadi, the terrorist diplomat of the

This act has made the Islamic Republic more active in terror organizing on European soil while it gives the green light to the ruling regime of Iran in actions against the Iranian opposition in Europe. This act also persuades the regime to intensify its hostage-taking policy of European citizens for the release of the terrorists of reaime whilst the it undermines the overall security of Iranians in Europe. We want to ensure the security of Iranian citizens who oppose the Islamic Republic in European countries, end the deal on the release of the terrorists of the Islamic Republic, and prevent the criminal actions of the ruling regime of Iran

against the Iranian opposition in Europe.

#### **Civil Disobedience**

The "Women. Life. Freedom" movement has declined in the form of street demonstrations, but its daily manifestation can be seen as civil disobedience in the streets, workplaces, and schools. The reaction of the students of the University of Arts to the notification of the University's Dean in regard to observing forced hijab is an example of dozens of such daily cases. They have announced to the universitv administration that "we have nothing to say to you except one word: NO".



The mentioned reaction is the basis of the





declaration of the Political Executive Committee of the Left Party of Iran, which writes:

The word "NO" said by the students of the University of Arts is, in fact, the "NO" of our society to the rule of force and oppression of the Islamic Republic. One of the great achievements of the "Women, Life, Freedom" movement is breaking the compulsory hijab in the public arena of society. The leaders of the Islamic Republic, who dream of returning to the days before the movement are still trying to re-impose the mandatory hijab by sealing restaurants and business centers, launching new bands of thugs, putting

pressure on women in the and harassing streets, them in the media. Those acts have so far been futile. By threatening, extorting, deporting, and suspending students, the regime is trying to suppress the student movement, which was one of the bases of resistance against the government's oppression, and to re-impose the compulsory hijab in universities.

the Disgusted bv reactionary policies of the Islamic Republic, the Left Party of Iran supports the struggles of the students of the University of Arts in defense of the achievements of the freedom women, life, movement, along with the declaration of solidarity of the students of universities across the country. We invite all freedom-fighters forces to support the students' struggles to push back the government from the universities and return security and freedom to the classrooms and universities. The goal of the Islamic Republic is to crush

the revolutionary movement of the people and to crush the student movement as one of the pillars of the women, life, freedom movement. A goal that should be buried with the burial of the Islamic Republic itself.

The Left Party of Iran condemns the attack on the camp of the People's Mojahedin Organization in Albania and the ban on holding the rally of this organization in Paris. We consider it a violation of their rights and freedoms within the framework of the rules and principles of Western societies.
